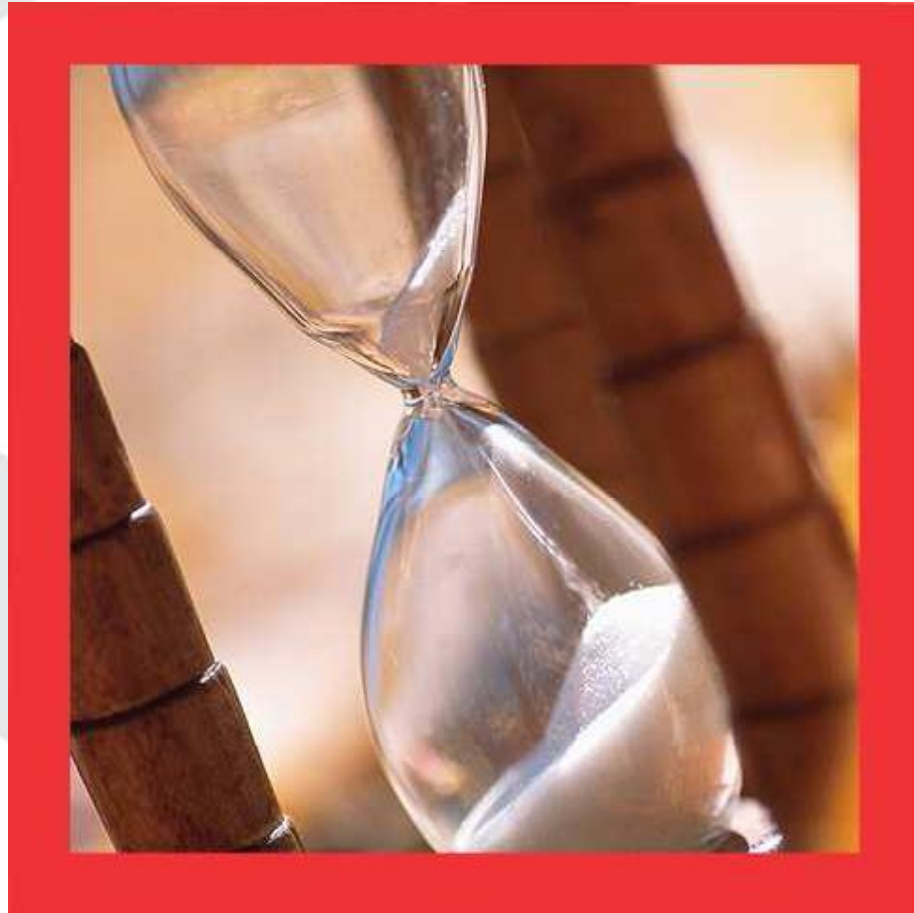

**Dr. Paul Rahn**

- Dr. Paul Rahn establishes his first business school in Berlin.

**1990**



**Gotthard Dittrich**

- Gotthard Dittrich establishes the Business Academy Dr. P. Rahn & Partner GmbH in Leipzig. Due to the increasing demand within the following years, more academies are founded in Saxony, Saxony-Anhalt, Thuringia and Brandenburg.

## 1993

- Dr. P. Rahn & Partner Schulen in freier Trägerschaft, gemeinnützige Schulgesellschaft mbH - our non-profit organisation - is founded. The first vocational school is situated in Leipzig. Rahn Dittrich Group starts up with international activities in Zielona Gora/Poland.

**1996**

- Rahn Dittrich Group starts working in **Cairo/Egypt** and **Budapest/Hungary**.

**1997**

- The first **primary school "Clara Schumann"** is opened in Leipzig.

**2002**

- The **German-Egyptian Hotel School Paul Rahn** is founded in **El Gouna/Egypt**.

## 2003

- The first high school of Rahn Dittrich Group is established in **Neuzelle**.
- A representative office is opened in **Cape Town / South Africa**.

## 2004

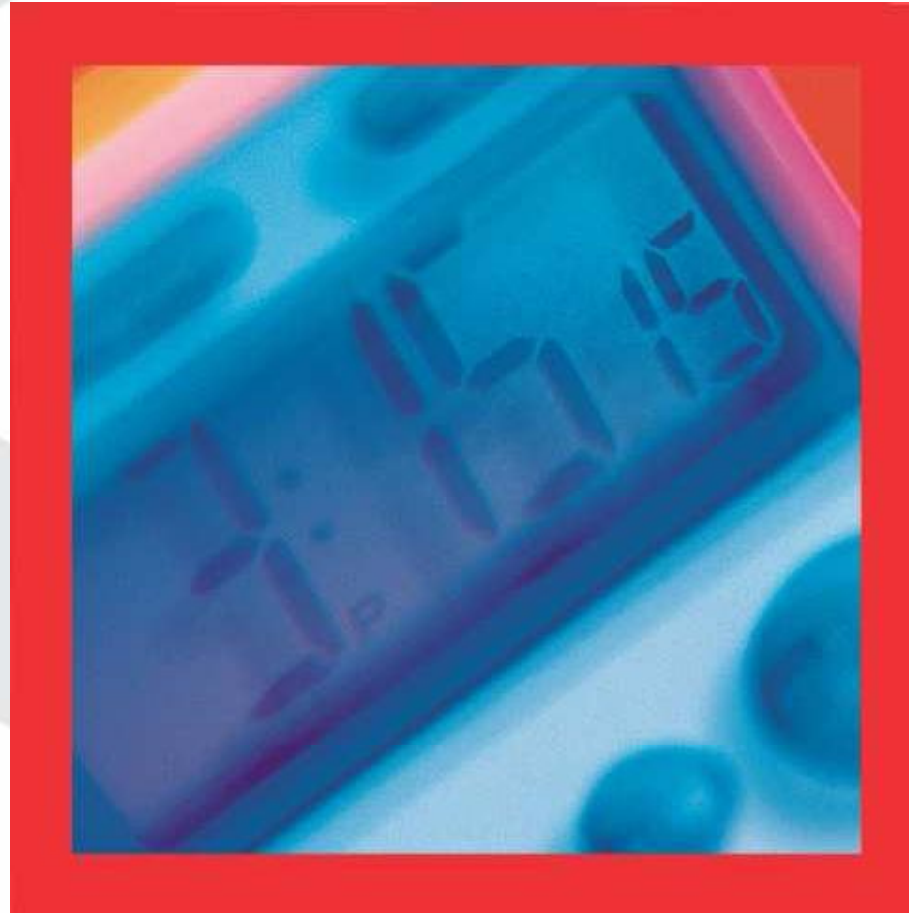
- A secondary school – “**Freie Mittelschule**” - is added to the schools of Rahn Dittrich Group in Leipzig.
- The **Private German School** starts in Cairo / Egypt.

## 2006

- To extend the business activities of Rahn Dittrich Group in Germany, **Educado Service Ltd.** is founded offering various services around education and training.
- Primary schools in Leipzig and Fürstenwalde start with K-classes (**daycare**).

## 2007

- The first **day nursery** of Rahn Dittrich Group is opened in Leipzig.
- A **primary school** in Altenburg and a **high school „Musikalisch-Sportliches Gymnasium“** in Leipzig start at the school year 2007/2008.

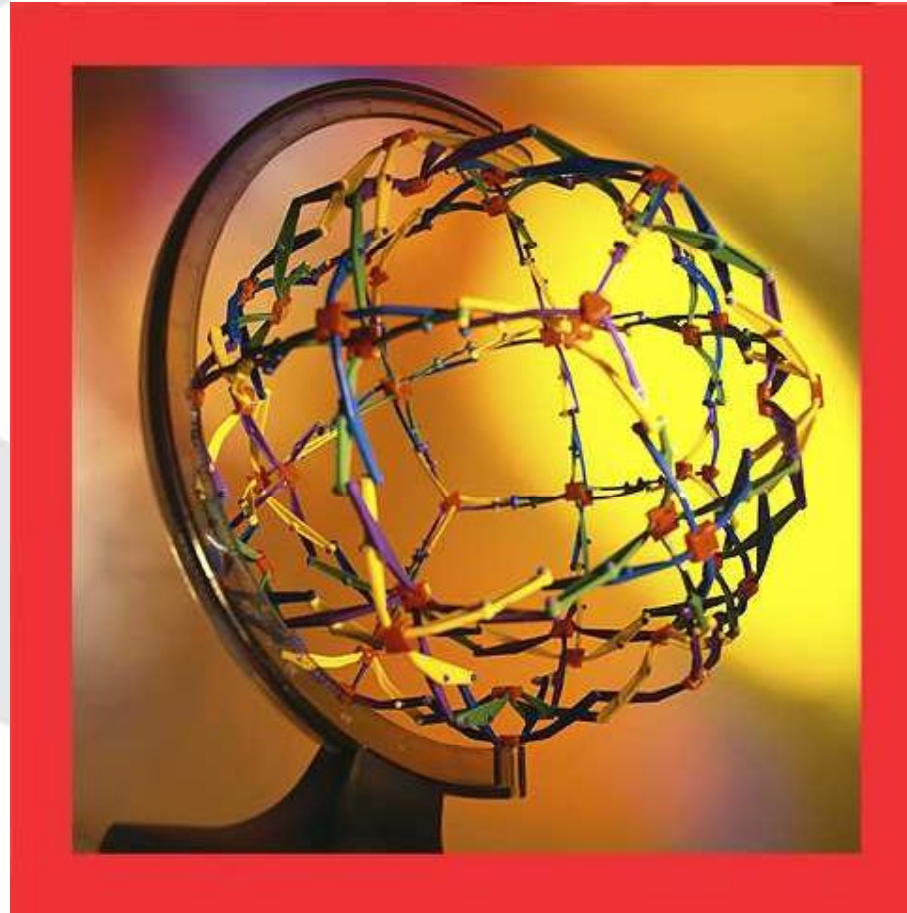

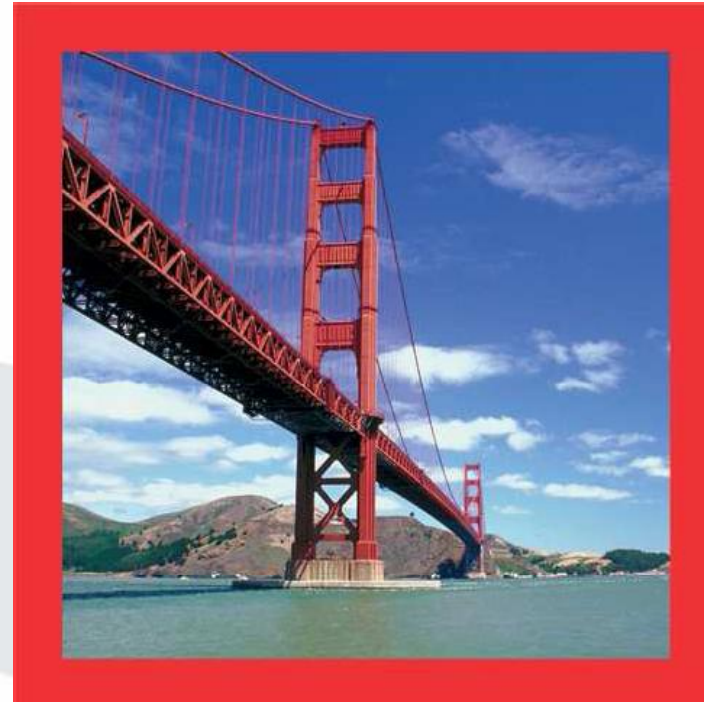
